Welcome to our Kaiwaka Basketball Module. This Module is social and is an opportunity for family and friends to come together and have lots of fun while keeping fit and enjoying a fun game of basketball!

Games:

Games will be held inside the KSA's gymnasium on Wednesday evenings beginning 24th May. The first game will begin at 6.45pm and managers will be informed of their teams game time. There will be four eight minute quarters, with a 30 second break between quarters. Please make sure your team is ready 5 minutes prior to your start time. Rules & regulations:

Maximum of 14 in a team with 5 on the court. No age restriction. At least 2 females on the court. As this is a social Module and the teams are mixed with men, women and children, there are a few special rules to make sure that the games stay friendly: girls guard girls, a guy cannot block the shot of a girl or steal the ball off her when she is dribbling, and rebounding is not to be aggressive. These rules will be monitored by the referees and anyone who is considered to be playing in an overly combative manner, will be warned, and for repeated infringements will be asked to leave. Only registered players may play in the Module – if you cannot field a team due to sickness, injuries etc, you may only bring in 'ring-ins' with the approval of your opposition.

Refereeing:

I will provide umpires. Please respect the umpires decisions.

Prizegiving:

Will be held after the last round. Prize money will be awarded to the top 3 teams.

Uniform:

Shorts and t-shirts. Feel free to have your team wear the same coloured shirts – maybe sponsored by a local business? Bibs and balls provided.

Points System:

3 = win
2 = draw
1 = loss
0 = default (win by default = 3 - 0, loss by default = 0 - 3 loss)

First Aid:

Each team is responsible for their own medical conditions. There is a first aid kit in the gymnasium.

Managers duties:

The manager will be responsible for their team playing the fee, for their team arriving on time, having enough players to take the court and for their teams behaviour on the court.
